ORDER CANCELING PRIVATE PAY TELEPHONE CERTIFICATE

This order cancels the private pay telephone certificate of Branson Telephone, LLC.

On March 29, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting that the certificate of Branson Telephone to provide private pay telephone services be canceled. Branson Telephone submitted a letter dated March 21, 2005, to Staff stating that it had not had pay telephone operations since 1995 and requesting the certificate be "withdrawn". Branson Telephone, LLC, was granted a certificate in Case No. TA-95-326. Staff stated that Branson Telephone owes no assessment fees and had no other matters pending before the Commission.

Section 392.410, RSMo 2000, gives the Commission authority over the granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed the motion and finds that the private payphone certificate granted to Branson Telephone, LLC, in Case No. TA-95-326 should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the private payphone certificate granted to Branson Telephone, LLC, in
 Case No. TA-95-326 is canceled.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on May 9, 2005.

3. That this case may be closed on May 10, 2005.
