ORDER CANCELING PRIVATE PAY TELEPHONE CERTIFICATES

Effective Date: November 25, 2005

This order cancels the private pay telephone certificates of KL Marketing Corp., d/b/a Advanced Coin Telephone, Farthing Enterprises, Inc., Gateway Payphone, Inc., Missouri Public Payphone Corporation, MO-KAN Telecom, Inc., and Phillips Maduros Enterprises, Inc. (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Providers").

On October 13, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting that the certificates to provide pay telephone service of the Providers be canceled. Staff alleges none of the Providers had returned a statement of revenue for at least the past two years. In addition, Staff states that each of the Providers is a Missouri corporation which was administratively dissolved by the Office of the Missouri Secretary of State. Section 351.476(1), RSMo 2000, states that "[a] dissolved corporation continues its corporate existence but may not carry on any business except that appropriate to wind up and liquidate its business and affairs"

Staff argues that by failing to maintain their authorization to operate in the state of Missouri and by failing to return statements of revenue the Providers have violated their certificates to provide payphone services.

Staff served its motion on the registered agent for service of process of each of the Providers. No responses to Staff's motion were filed.

Section 392.410, RSMo 2000, gives the Commission authority over the granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed the motion and finds that the private payphone certificates granted to each of the Providers shall be canceled.

To ensure that the Providers have had every opportunity to respond, the Commission shall order its Data Center to serve a copy of this order on the company address and the registered agent addresses as listed in Staff's motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the private payphone certificate granted to KL Marketing Corp., d/b/a Advanced Coin Telephone, in Case No. TA-97-179 is canceled.
2. That the private payphone certificate granted to Farthing Enterprises, Inc., in Case No. TA-99-36 is canceled.
3. That the private payphone certificate granted to Gateway Payphone, Inc., in Case No. TA-92-96 is canceled.
4. That the private payphone certificate granted to Missouri Public Payphone Corporation in Case No. TA-99-541 is canceled.
5. That the private payphone certificate granted to MO-KAN Telecom, Inc., in Case No. TA-98-190 is canceled.

6. That the private payphone certificate granted to Phillips Maduros Enterprises, Inc., in Case No. TA-98-190 is canceled.

7. That the Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of this order to each of the companies and to their registered agents at the addresses as listed in Staff's motion.

8. That this order shall become effective on November 25, 2005.

9. That this case may be closed on November 26, 2005.
