ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

Issue Date: April 19, 2007

Effective Date: April 29, 2007

On March 22, 2007, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel the certificate of service authority granted to William J. Crews d/b/a Metropolitan Public Communications and d/b/a Bell-Tone Enterprise. In its motion, Staff states that Mr. Crews was granted a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the state of Missouri in Case No. TA-89-258. As shown in the case file, Mr. Crews used the fictitious names of Bell-Tone Enterprise and Metropolitan Public Communications. Staff's motion was prompted by Mr. Crews' request that his certificate be canceled.

Staff informs the Commission that no complaints have been filed against the company since the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System has been in place. Staff further states that Mr. Crews has paid all assessments.

Under Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) parties shall not be allowed more than ten days in which to file a responsive pleading. More than ten days have expired since Staff filed its motion and Mr. Crews has not responded.

Section 392.410.5, RSMo 2000, states: "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected. . . ." The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and finds that granting the motion is reasonable. The Commission will therefore cancel the certificate of service authority granted to Mr. Crews in Case No. TA-89-258.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Certificate of Service Authority to provide private pay telephone service in the state of Missouri granted to William J. Crews d/b/a Metropolitan Public Communications and d/b/a Bell-Tone Enterprise in Case No. TA-89-258 is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on April 29, 2007.
3. This case may be closed on April 30, 2007.
