Williams (Williams), attorney for OWC, informed Staff by telephone that OWC had agreed to withdraw its application. On September 3, 1999, Williams faxed a letter to the Commission in which he reiterated that OWC does not intend to proceed with this case.

On September 7, 1999, Staff filed its notice regarding withdrawal of OWC's application and request to cancel hearing. Staff stated that it opposed OWC's application for a certificate and supported OWC's letter-form request to cancel the hearing. Staff also requested that the hearing be canceled.

The Commission will order the evidentiary hearing in this matter canceled and the case dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the evidentiary hearing in this matter is canceled and this case is dismissed.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective October 1, 1999.

3. That this may be closed on October 4, 1999.
