ORDER GRANTING LATE INTERVENTION

By order dated June 15, 1999 the Commission set an intervention deadline of July 6. On September 22, 1999, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc., TCG St. Louis, Inc., and TCG Kansas City, Inc. (collectively, Applicants) filed an application to intervene out of time. In their application, Applicants state that they chose initially not to intervene, but after discussion with parties to the case, they now believe they must intervene to protect their interests. They assert that their interests are different from the general public, and that no party to the case can protect those interests.

The Commission has reviewed the application to intervene and finds that it is in substantial compliance with Commission rules regarding intervention and that Applicants have interests in this matter that are different from those of the general public. The Commission finds that Applicants have demonstrated good cause for not timely filing their application to intervene, and will grant it.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc., TCG St. Louis, Inc., and TCG Kansas City, Inc. are granted intervention.
2. That this order shall become effective on October 15, 1999.

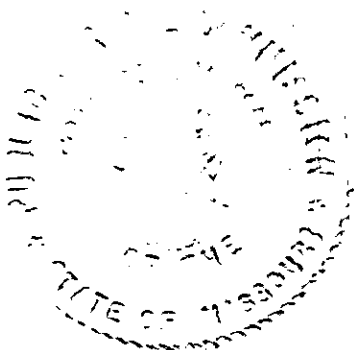
