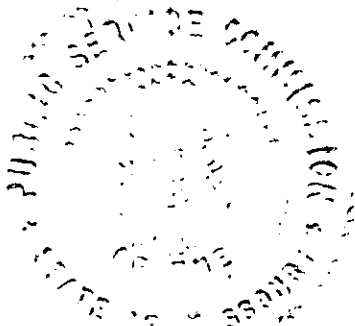
ORDER DIRECTING FILING
