## ORDER REGARDING NOTICE

On June 10, 1999, the Commission issued a Report and Order in which it, inter alia, ordered Craw-Kan Telephone Cooperative (Craw-Kan) to submit to the Commission for approval a second notice concerning IntraLATA Dialing Parity (ILDP) that is to be sent to Craw-Kan's customers. On September 13, 1999, Craw-Kan submitted the notice, along with a cover letter, requesting that the Commission approve it. On September 22, 1999, Craw-Kan filed a pleading in which it reiterated the request it made in its September 13, 1999, letter.

In order to more fully inform Craw-Kan's customers of their options, the Commission will direct Craw-Kan to add the following paragraph at the end of its proposed notice:

You will still be able to make toll calls by "dialing around" using a "101XXXX" access number. A list of these "101XXXX" access numbers is available from your local Craw-Kan Telephone Cooperative business office.

With this modification, the notice accurately reflects the choices that Craw-Kan's customers have, and the Commission will therefore allow Craw-Kan to send it.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Craw-Kan Rural Telephone Cooperative shall be allowed to send the proposed second customer notice submitted on September 13, 1999 with the modification discussed herein.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on October 5, 1999.
