ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE

On November 1, 2001, the Commission's Staff filed its recommendation and memorandum presenting seven financial adjustments affecting three of the operating districts of Atmos Energy Corporation as part of Staff's review of the Corporation's 1999-2000 Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) filing. Staff's adjustments also take into account the sale of Associated Natural Gas Company's assets to Atmos.

Staff also recommends that Atmos be required to provided certain additional information by February 28, 2002, related to the Corporation's planning, assumptions and preparation to serve its end user customers prudently. Staff asked that the Commission order Atmos to respond within 30 days. The Commission assumes that Staff requires this information to be presented in a report directly to Staff.

A response from Atmos will inform the Commission what matters are contested between the parties. Therefore, the Commission will direct Atmos to respond.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That Atmos Energy Corporation shall respond to the recommendations for necessary financial adjustments and corresponding actions presented by Staff within 30 days of the issue date of this order.
- 2. That Atmos Energy Corporation shall respond and state whether it accepts the recommendation by Staff that it report certain additional information by February 28, 2002.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on November 17, 2001.
