

ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On August 2, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff and Commission) filed a report on mediation. Nothing further has been filed since that date. The mediation referral order issued by the Commission on May 25, 2000, stated, *inter alia*, that each party shall advise the Commission in writing of the status of the mediation process by letter no later than the last day of each month beginning on the last day of July of the year 2000.

Staff and Discount Manufactured Housing, Inc. will be directed to advise the Commission in writing of the status of the mediation process by letter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and Discount Manufactured Housing, Inc. shall, no later than September 22, 2000, advise the Missouri Public Service Commission in writing of the status of the mediation process by letter and then shall adhere to the

mediation referral order as set out in that original order which was issued on May 25, 2000, by the Missouri Public Service Commission.

2. That this order shall become effective on September 18, 2000.
