ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On February 8, 1999, the parties filed a document entitled "Proposed Procedural Schedule." The document states that the parties met on January 20, 1999 for a prehearing conference. Applicant indicated to the other parties that given its resources and limited number of potential customers, it does not wish to litigate this tariff. Applicant is, however, interested in learning the concerns of the other parties and in pursuing approval of the proposed tariff through negotiation.

The document states that the parties have agreed to meet again on February 25, 1999 for a technical conference to further define and discuss the issues related to the proposed "Green Power" tariff. The document states that at this conference, the Parties will determine the need for additional meetings and will report to the Commission.

The Commission interprets this document to be a request for an extension of time to file a procedural schedule. The Commission will grant an extension of time.
