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

**ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**  
**AND DIRECTING FILING**

On July 21, 2000, the parties herein filed their Stipulation and Agreement, seeking the approval of the Commission for a settlement disposing of all issues in the case. While the Commission considers the parties' Stipulation and Agreement, it will suspend the existing procedural schedule in order to spare the parties effort and expense in preparing for hearing that may well be unnecessary. Furthermore, the Commission will direct Staff to file its recommendation and memorandum by August 7, 2000, due to the effective date of the tariff herein.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the procedural schedule established herein by order issued on April 13, 2000, is suspended until further order of the Commission.
2. That the Staff of the Public Service Commission shall file a recommendation and memorandum in response to the stipulation and agreement no later than August 7, 2000.

3. That this order shall become effective on August 1, 2000.
