ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS FILED IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION DECISION

On March 18, 1999, the Commission issued its order granting a certificate of service authority to NET-tel Corporation d/b/a NET-tel Communications Corporation (NET-tel) authorizing it to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri. The Commission also granted NET-tel a temporary waiver of 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H). The Commission directed NET-tel to submit its tariffs for Commission approval within 30 days of the effective date of the Commission's order approving its interconnection agreement.

The Commission approved NET-tel's interconnection agreement with Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) in Case No. TO-99-282 effective March 23, 1999. NET-tel requested and was granted an extension of time to file its proposed tariff sheets until July 13, 1999. On July 13, NET-tel filed the tariff sheets as required with an effective date of August 27, 1999. On August 11, 12, and 17, NET-tel

filed substitute tariff sheets. NET-tel also extended the effective of its tariff sheets on August 17, from August 27 to September 3.

On August 20, Staff filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve the proposed tariff sheets as modified to become effective on September 3, 1999. Staff stated that it had reviewed the tariff sheets and substituted tariff sheets and it is of the opinion that the tariff sheets and substitute tariff sheets are acceptable. Staff also stated that NET-tel's proposed tariff sheets cover the provision of resold telecommunications services for the use of residential and business customers.

The Commission has reviewed NET-tel's tariff filing and Staff's memorandum. The Commission finds that the tariff sheets and substitute tariff sheets filed that comply with the Commission's order and should be approved for service rendered on or after September 3, 1999.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Tariff File No. 0000038, submitted in Case No. TA-99-180 by NET-tel Corporation d/b/a NET-tel Communications Corporation, is hereby approved for service to be rendered on or after September 3, 1999:
