ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On June 23, 1994, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWB or Applicant) submitted tariff sheets proposing to introduce a new section (Section 22, Coin Service) pertaining to coin telephone service to its access services tariff. SWB states that language pertaining to Coin Service, which was found in other tariff sections, is being consolidated in this new section. SWB also states that new language is being added to maintain agreement with their presently effective interstate tariff. The proposed language does not introduce any new features or modify the services currently being provided to interexchange carriers who serve pay telephones.

On July 8, 1994, Midwest Independent Coin Payphone Association (MICPA) filed a Motion for an Order Suspending Tariffs in this case. On July 19, 1994, SWB filed a response to MICPA's Motion and on August 2, 1994, MICPA withdrew its motion for suspension.

On August 11, 1994, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its Memorandum in which it recommended approval of the Applicant's tariff. The Commission has reviewed both the tariff sheets as submitted by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company and the Staff Memorandum. The Commission finds that the tariff would clarify how access

service would be provided for pay telephones and should be approved for service on and after August 17, 1994.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the tariff sheets filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company on June 23, 1994, are hereby approved for service on and after August 17, 1994:
