ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On October 5, 1994, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) submitted a proposal to reduce the prices of the Block-of-Time Option of its 1+ Saver Optional Calling Plan. The 1+ Saver is an optional toll offering to residence and business customers which allows subscribers to receive a discount on qualified long distance usage. SWBT is now proposing to reduce the prices on its 1+ Saver Block-of-Time to be consistent with the recent decrease of its MTS rates. The proposed change for the first hour Block-of-Time would be a reduction from the current rate of \$9.60 an hour to \$8.35 an hour and the proposed change for every additional hour in the Block-of-Time plan would be a reduction from \$9.00 an hour to \$7.80 an hour. SWBT has also requested expedited treatment of this request so that the time from the MTS price reduction to the corresponding 1+ Saver Block-of-Time price reduction will be minimized.

On October 25, 1994, the Public Service Commission Staff (Staff) filed its Memorandum in which it recommended approval of the tariff for service on and after November 4, 1994 and Staff recommended that the tariff be approved on or before that date.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff filed by SWBT as well as the Staff Memorandum and the entirety of the file and finds that the tariff

to reduce these prices is just and reasonable. The Commission will approve the tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheet filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company on October 5, 1994, is hereby approved for service on and after October 29, 1994.
