ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On December 15, 1994, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. (AT&T) filed a proposed tariff sheet to extend the AT&T Prepaid Card service promotion to January 31, 1995. The proposed tariff provides that customers who purchase an AT&T Prepaid Card during the promotional period will receive a promotional rate of \$.45 per unit during the promotional period in lieu of the rates otherwise specified in Section 1.4.11.D of the Missouri Message Telecommunications Service tariff. AT&T requested that the tariff be allowed to go into effect by January 1, 1995, or as soon as possible thereafter to avoid a break in the promotional rate.

On December 22, 1994, the Commission Staff (Staff) filed its memorandum regarding the proposed tariff sheet. Staff states that it has no objection to the proposed tariff or AT&T's request for expedited Commission consideration of this proposal. Staff therefore recommends that the Commission approve the proposed filing at its earliest convenience and allow the tariff page to become effective on January 1, 1995.

Having reviewed the proposed tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation, the Commission determines that the proposed tariff sheet should be approved because AT&T is in the competitive interstate telecommunications market and approval of this tariff is in the public interest.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff sheet filed by AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc., on December 15, 1994, is hereby approved to become effective on January 1, 1995:

2. That this order shall become effective on the 1st day of January, 1995.
