ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On February 6, 1995, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. (AT&T) submitted a proposed tariff sheet to the Public Service Commission (Commission) designed to extend its operator services promotion. This promotion offers discounted rates for operator handled collect calls and was originally approved on August 5, 1994, to be in effect from July 23, 1994 through July 31, 1994. On October 18th, and December 22, 1994, the Commission approved extensions which permitted the program to continue through January 31, 1995. AT&T is now requesting that the program be extended through April 30, 1995. AT&T requested expedited treatment of its request.

On February 14, 1995, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum giving its recommendation. Staff stated that it had reviewed the proposed tariff sheet and that Staff has no objection to extending the operator services promotion through April 30, 1995. Staff recommended that the tariff be approved at the Commission's earliest convenience.

Having reviewed the company's tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that AT&T's request to extend its operator services promotion is reasonable. The Commission finds that the tariff sheet submitted on February 6, 1995, is in the public interest and

should be approved. The Commission also finds that good cause exists for permitting the tariff to take effect on less than 30 days notice.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**


1. That the tariff submitted by AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. on February 6, 1995, be approved for service on and after February 23, 1995. The tariff sheet approved is:
