ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On August 28, 1991, this Commission granted a certificate of service authority to Mid-Com Communications, Inc. (Company) to provide competitive intrastate interexchange telecommunications service. Company's certificate was conditional on approval of its tariff, which Company initially submitted on October 8, 1991. Following discussion with Staff, Company resubmitted said tariff on October 15, 1991, October 28, 1991, and December 23, 1991. On December 31, 1991, Company requested that its tariff be effective on January 9, 1992.

Staff filed its recommendation on January 2, 1992. Staff states that Company's proposed tariff meets the conditions of Company's certificate and incorporates suggestions made to Company by Staff. Staff recommends that Company's tariff be approved.

Having considered Company's tariff and Staff's recommendation, the Commission has determined that said tariff is reasonable and will be approved for service rendered on and after January 9, 1992.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That tariff sheets PSC Mo. No. 1, comprised of Original Sheet Nos. 1 through 47, inclusive, as amended by Mid-Com Communications, Inc. on December 23, 1991, is hereby approved for service rendered on or after January 9, 1992.

2. That this order shall be effective on January 9, 1992.
