ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEET

On October 25, 1995, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. (AT&T) filed a proposed tariff sheet designed to extend its Prepaid Card Service Promotion through March 31, 1996. This promotion allows customers who purchase a prepaid card during the promotional period to receive the promotional rate of \$.35 per unit instead of the current rate of \$.45 per unit. AT&T has requested expedited consideration if its proposal.

On November 8, 1995, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve AT&T's proposed tariff sheet. Staff stated it has no objections to the proposed tariff sheet or to its approval on an expedited basis.

Upon review of the proposed tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that AT&T's proposal is reasonable. Thus, the Commission determines that the tariff sheet filed by AT&T on October 25, 1995 should be approved for service on and after November 15, 1995.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff sheet filed by AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. is hereby approved for service on and after November 15, 1995:

4th Revised Preface Sheet No. 7 Canceling 3rd Revised Preface Sheet No. 7.

2. That this Order shall become effective on November 15, 1995.
