ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

On May 15, 1996, Sprint Communications Company, L.P. (Sprint) filed tariff sheets designed to introduce "Restricted Service" and Sprint Sense Stand Alone FONCARD" services. Sprint also proposed a miscellaneous text change. Sprint requested expedited treatment of the tariff sheets. After discussion with the Staff of the Commission (Staff), Sprint withdrew the proposed "Restricted Service" tariff sheets.

The proposed "Sprint Sense Stand Alone FONCARD" is a calling card available to non-Sprint subscribers. The proposed rate is \$0.35 per minute and applicable surcharges apply if an operator assists with the call. The proposed text change clarifies the language in Sprint's Message Telecommunications Service to separate the "Sprint Sense Stand Alone FONCARD" from Sprint's regular FONCARD.

On June 5, 1996, Staff filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve Sprint's proposed tariff sheets. Staff stated that it had no objections to the proposed tariff sheets or to their approval on an expedited basis.

Upon review of the proposed tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that Sprint's proposal is reasonable. Thus, the Commission finds that the tariff sheets filed by Sprint on

May 15, 1996, and not withdrawn, should be approved for service on and after June 14, 1996.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff sheets filed by Sprint Communications Company, L.P. are hereby approved for service on and after June 14, 1996:

4th Revised Sheet No. 48 Canceling 3rd Revised Sheet No. 48;
2nd Revised Sheet No. A-6 Canceling 1st Revised Sheet No. A-6.

2. That this Order shall become effective on June 14, 1996.
