ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS

On August 5, 1994, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWB) filed tariff sheets to remove United Telephone Company of Missouri's (United) Lake Lotawana exchange from the list of exchanges for which SWB acts as the Primary Toll Carrier (PTC). This case was established because SWB requested the tariffs be approved effective in less than thirty days, on August 19, 1994. On August 12, 1994, Commission Staff filed a memorandum recommending approval of the tariffs and recommending the approval of United's tariffs to rehome the Lake Lotawana exchange and elimination of certain calling plans.

The Commission has considered the tariff sheets and finds that SWB's should be approved. The Commission finds further that there is good cause to approve the tariffs on less than thirty days notice. The Commission also finds that United's tariff sheets should be approved. These tariff sheets are a complement to SWB's tariffs. The approval of these separate tariffs will make United the PTC for Lake Lotawana, for which it also provides local service.

The approval of United's tariffs will also note that upon the approval of these tariffs, Lake Lotawana customers who formerly subscribed to the Metropolitan Optional Service Plan and optional Extended Area Service will now be subscribers to Metropolitan Calling Area service at a lower rate for a larger

calling scope. These changes in service are consistent with the Commission's Report And Order in TO-92-306.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheets filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company to remove the Lake Lotawana exchange from the list of exchanges for which it is the Primary Toll Carrier be hereby approved for service on and after August 19, 1994. The tariff sheets approved are:
