ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS

On April 20, 1990, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWB) submitted to the Commission tariffs designed to remove the transitionally competitive classification from Call Control Options, Microlink I and Selective Call Forwarding. SWB filed a motion for expedited consideration of these tariffs and requested a less than 30 day effective date. The motion and tariffs were filed in conjunction with SWB's motion to withdraw Case No. TO-89-56, in which SWB was seeking transitionally competitive classifications for certain other services. The Commission had consolidated the consideration of the classification of Call Control Options, Microlink I and Selective Call Forwarding in Case No. TO-89-56.

Commission Staff filed a memorandum that the Commission approve the tariffs as filed. The fixed rates SWB proposes for these services once they are no longer transitionally competitive are the minimum rates now reflected in the band of rates. This is the current rate level used by SWB.

The Commission in an order issued May 2, 1990 granted SWB's motion to withdraw its request to classify certain services as transitionally competitive. SWB filed the tariffs at issue herein to remove the transitionally competitive classification from Call Control Options, Microlink I and Selective Call Forwarding. Since SWB has indicated it no longer wishes to have these services classified as


transitionally competitive, the Commission will approve these tariffs. The current rates will be maintained for the services.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the tariffs filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company to remove the transitionally competitive classification from Call Control Options, Microlink I and Selective Call Forwarding are hereby approved for service on or after May 20, 1990.

ORDERED: 2. That this order shall become effective on the 20th day of May, 1990.
