ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS

On September 5, 1990, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (Bell) filed a proposed tariff correcting its intraLATA Message Telecommunications Service (MTS) toll rate schedule to reflect the rates approved by the Commission on October 1, 1989. Although the tariffs show an effective date of October 8, 1990, Bell requested expedited consideration.

On September 5, 1990, the Commission Staff (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending approval of the tariff and that Commission consideration be expedited. Staff stated the rates were unintentionally changed in a separate tariff filing which became effective on July 15, 1990 which re-established Extended Measured Service for three Community Optional Service (COS) routes offering only one-way COS. Staff further stated that it recently became aware of the tariff discrepancy and notified SWB officials. Staff stated that customers should not be affected by this filing since SWB has continued to apply the same rate structure since October 1, 1989 and that Commission approval should be expedited in order to facilitate the proposed revision as soon as possible. Staff recommended that an Order Approving Tariffs be issued which would allow the proposed tariffs to become effective on the date Commission approval is obtained.

In view of the foregoing, the Commission determines that the tariff filed herein should be approved on less than thirty (30) days notice for good cause shown pursuant to Section 392.220(2), RSMo Supp. 1988 for service rendered on and after September 7, 1990.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff filed herein by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company on September 5, 1990, is approved hereby for service rendered on and after September 8, 1990.
