

**SECOND ORDER CHANGING DEADLINE FOR
FILING OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On June 6, 2001, the Director filed a motion to extend the deadline for the filing of a procedural schedule until June 15, 2001, because the parties are discussing how best to resolve the matter and expect to have it settled by June 11, 2001. The Director stated the motion was filed under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.050(3) which provides that

[w]hen an act is required or allowed to be done by order or rule of the commission at or within a specified time, the commission, at its discretion, may [o]rder the period enlarged before the expiration of the period originally prescribed or as extended by a previous order....

The Commission will grant the Director's motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the procedural schedule must be filed no later than June 18, 2001.
