

ORDER FINDING NECESSITY FOR RULEMAKING

On January 18, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion opening a case to consider the necessity of a rule to correct an incorrect statutory citation within the rule. On February 16, 2000, the Staff filed its Motion for Finding of Necessity for Rulemaking with a memorandum attached in support of its motion.

Staff proposes an amendment to the rule, 4 CSR 240-121.180, to ensure that the rule properly cites the statutory authority for the Public Service Commission. Currently, rule 4 CSR 240-121.180 cites Section 700.205, RSMo, which does not exist, and replaces it with Section 700.090, RSMo, which deals with the registration requirements for dealers.

The Staff memorandum demonstrates that the proposed rule is necessary to correct an incorrect statutory citation within the rule. The Staff states that there is no fiscal impact of this proposed rule to the

state and to private or public persons or entities that will be affected by the rule.

Pursuant to Section 536.016, RSMo (Cum. Supp. 1999), a state agency is required to find, based upon substantial evidence on the record, that a proposed rule is necessary to carry out the purposes of the statute that granted the rulemaking authority. Based on the record, the Commission finds that the proposed amendment to rule 4 CSR 240-121.180, Monthly Report Requirement for Registered Manufactured Home Dealers, is necessary to correct an incorrect citation and carry out the purposes of Section 700.460, RSMo (1994).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission is authorized to proceed with the necessary procedures of the Commission and applicable procedures of administrative rulemaking and may file a proposed amendment to the rule in this case for the Commission's consideration.

2. That this order shall become effective on March 28, 2000.
