## ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

By an order issued on June 20, 2000, the Commission directed the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than August 1. At the request of the parties, that date was extended, first to October 2, and then to October 31. On October 31, Staff filed a Motion for Additional Time to File Procedural Schedule.

Staff's motion indicates that efforts to settle the case are continuing and that Staff requires additional time to obtain and analyze financial documentation regarding the reasonableness of the proposed purchase price for this utility. Staff requests an additional fourteen days, until November 14, to either file a proposed procedural schedule, or to advise the Commission when a stipulation and agreement will be filed. Staff represents that no party has an objection to Staff's request for additional time.

The Commission has considered Staff's Motion for Additional Time to File Procedural Schedule and finds that it should be granted.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Staff's Motion for Additional Time to File Procedural Schedule is granted.

- 2. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than November 14, 2000.
  - 3. That this order shall become effective on November 12, 2000.
