## ORDER APPROVING INTERIM BOWLING GREEN DISTRICT RATES

United Cities Gas Company (United) of Franklin, Tennessee, submitted a tariff sheet to the Commission on August 30, 1999, carrying an effective date of October 1, 1999. The tariff sheet was filed to reflect changes in the Bowling Green District's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors as a result of an increase in the spot market cost of gas and a change in the refund factor. These changes will increase United's annualized revenues by approximately \$63,900. The impact on a typical residential space-heating customer using 42 Ccf of natural gas in the month of October will be an increase of \$1.73 or 5.3%.

The Missouri Public Service Commission Staff (Staff) filed a memorandum stating that the change in United's PGA was calculated in conformance with United's approved PGA Clause and recommends that the Commission approve the tariff sheet to become effective on October 1, 1999. Staff recommends that the tariff sheet be approved on an interim basis, subject to refund, until the Commission makes its final determinations in Case Nos. GR-98-274 and GR-99-280.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation, and finds t3hat the tariff sheet conforms to its Commission-approved PGA Clause and is therefore reasonable. After considering Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the proposed tariff sheet should be approved to become effective on and after the requested effective date of October 1, 1999, interim subject to refund.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheet submitted on August 30, 1999, by United Cities Gas Company of Franklin, Tennessee, for the purpose of reflecting changes in rates for natural gas in its Bowling Green District, is approved on an interim basis, subject to refund, to become effective on October 1, 1999. The tariff sheet approved is:

2. That this order shall become effective October 1, 1999.
