ORDER ACCEPTING LATE FILED APPENDIX

On November 3, 1998, Mark Twain Rural Telephone Company (Mark Twain) filed an Application in which it requested authority to borrow money from the Rural Utilities Service and the Rural Telephone Bank. Along with the Application, Mark Twain filed a Motion for Protective Order. The Motion for Protective Order was granted by order of the Commission on November 10.
