ORDER ADOPTING TARIFF

On July 13, 1990, SK&M Water and Sewer Company (Company) filed a letter requesting a revenue increase pursuant to the Public Service Commission (Commission) informal rate procedure. The Commission Staff (Staff) recommended rates that included an increase of the minimum monthly service charge for a 5/8" meter from \$4.57 to \$4.69 and for a 1" meter from \$11.43 to \$11.71. The usage per 1,000 gallons would increase from \$1.90 to \$1.98 per 1,000 gallons. The Company submitted a tariff on November 26, 1990 which would have implemented Staff's recommended water rates, effective January 1, 1991. The Company extended the effective date to February 1, 1991. Staff recommended a revenue requirement increase of \$656 or 2%.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed rates and has determined that they are reasonable. The Commission is of the opinion that the tariff submitted on November 26, 1990 should be allowed to go into effect for service on and after February 1, 1991.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Missouri Public Service Commission hereby adopts the tariff filed herein on November 26, 1990.
- 2. That the tariff filed by SK&M Water and Sewer Company on November 26, 1990 to increase the Company's gross annual operating revenues by \$656 (exclusive of gross receipts and franchise taxes) are approved for service rendered on and after February 1, 1991

3. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
