ORDER AND NOTICE

On December 29, 1993, this docket was opened as the result of an order of the Commission approving a Stipulation and Agreement in Case No. ER-94-197, for the purpose of performing a customer class cost of service and comprehensive rate design study. In addition, it was agreed in the approved Stipulation and Agreement that an intervention period would be set.

The Applicant, Kansas City Power and Light (KCPL) is currently a public utility conducting business in the State of Missouri, and is engaged in the transmission and distribution of electric power under the jurisdiction of the Commission. KCPL has its home office and principal place of business at 1201 Walnut, Kansas City, Missouri 64106-2124.

In accordance with the Stipulation and Agreement in Case no. ER-94-197, the Commission finds that proper parties shall be given the opportunity to intervene in this matter. Applications to intervene shall be filed with the Executive Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission, 301 West High, Room 530, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102 within 30 days from the date of this order. Copies of applications to intervene should be sent to William G. Riggins, Kansas City Power & Light Company, 1201 Walnut, Kansas City, MO 64106-2124.

The Commission has also determined notice should be sent by the Records Department of the Commission to all those parties on the service list in Docket No.

In addition, the Commission finds that the Information Office of the Commission will send a copy of the notice in this matter to each newspaper located in the KCPL service area, as listed in the *Official Manual of the State of Missouri*, and to members of the General Assembly representing the area served by KCPL.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Records Department and Information Office of the Commission will give notice as set out herein.
2. That any proper party wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than 3:00 p.m. on March 7, 1994. Such application shall be filed with the Executive Secretary, Missouri Public Service Commission, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, MO 65102.
3. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
