ORDER APPROVING PROPOSED REVISED TARIFF

On July 12, 1993, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWB) filed a
proposed revision to tariff 19.1.6, Nonapplication of Service Charges, which
states:

"(1) for customers displaced by the major river flooding in
the summer of 1993, services charges do not apply to the
establishment of service at an interim location nor to the
later re-establishment of service at the same or another
location. This provision expires December 31, 1993."

The proposed effective date of the tariff revision is August 11, 1993.

On July 14, 1993, the Staff of the Commission filed its recommendation
stating that SWB's existing tariff already allows for one waiver of service
connection charges for reestablishment of service after the destruction or
partial destruction of a customer's premises due to fire, flood, or other natural
disasters. The Staff states that the pending proposal would extend the waiver
to allow an additional waiver of service charge for interim service to the
customer pending establishment of permanent service prior to December 31, 1993,
at the original or another permanent location.

The telecommunications department of the Staff stated that they had no
objection to the proposal and stated that it recommends the Commission approve
the proposal at its earliest convenience. The Staff stated that the proposed
revision provided appropriate relief for victims of the current flooding.

The Commission, after review of the proposed tariff revision and the Staff recommendation, finds the proposal to be appropriate in light of the current statewide situation and in the best interest of the public, and therefore approves the revised tariff sheets as filed by SWB.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the proposed tariff filing herein, consisting of a one-page tariff, that being PSC Mo. No. 35, General Exchange Tariff, Section 19, 2nd revised sheet 7 replacing 1st revised sheet 7, is hereby approved for service on and after the 11th day of August, 1993.

2. That this order shall become effective July 27, 1993.
