ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On December 14, 1993, United Telephone Company of Missouri (United) filed tariff sheets proposing to rehome the Buckner exchange from Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's (SWBT's) Kansas City toll complex to United's Warrensburg toll complex. On December 16, 1993, SWBT filed tariff sheets proposing to change its own tariff to also reflect the rehoming of the Buckner exchange. Both companies initially requested an effective date of December 20, 1993. Pursuant to a request of the Missouri Public Service Commission Staff (Staff), both companies subsequently extended the effective date until January 14, 1994 for United and January 15, 1994 for SWBT; however, both companies also requested that the effective date be expedited as much as possible.

Along with the rehoming of the Buckner exchange, United is proposing to downgrade its Oak Grove toll complex and rehome that toll traffic to the Warrensburg toll complex.

On December 21, 1993, the Staff filed its Memorandum in which it recommended an expedited approval of the tariffs. Staff has stated that these filings are similar to other rehoming tariffs previously approved by the Commission and that these filings accurately reflect changes in the companies' networks. Staff further requested that these tariffs be approved on an expedited basis and that the tariffs be made effective at the same time that the Commission rules on the proposed tariffs.

The Commission finds that the rehoming proposed by the Applicant is in the public interest and the Commission further finds that this rehoming is consistent with the Commission order issued in Case No. TT-94-119 regarding the primary toll carrier plan. After reviewing the proposed tariffs and the Staff recommendation, the Commission further finds that the tariff should be approved for service on and after December 23, 1993.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That United Telephone Company of Missouri be hereby authorized to implement the changes in the tariff sheets listed below for service on and after December 23, 1993:


