ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On January 4, 1995, Sprint Communications Company L.P. (Sprint) submitted a proposal to extend the Sprint Service Promotion which had previously been approved by the Commission to run from July 15, 1994 through January 13, 1995. This promotion offers discounts based upon the customers' monthly MTS usage of interstate and intrastate SPRINT Service, FONCARD, and Operator Service usage and surcharges. Sprint's proposed tariff has an effective date of February 3, 1995.

On January 20, 1995, the Telecommunications Staff of the Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its Memorandum in which it recommended approval of the proposed tariff. Staff has indicated that at its request Sprint submitted a substitute page on January 17, 1995.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheet as proposed by Sprint along with the Staff Memorandum and the contents of the file and finds that the tariff sheet merely extends services and rates which have been approved by the Commission. The Commission further finds that the rates and services offered herein are of a competitive nature and not detrimental to the public interest.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


1. That the tariff sheet submitted by Sprint Communications Company L.P. on January 4, 1995, be approved for service on and after February 3, 1995.
