ORDER CANCELING PRIVATE PAY TELEPHONE CERTIFICATE

Issue Date: December 19, 2005

Effective Date: December 29, 2005

On November 2, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting that the certificate to provide pay telephone service of J.T. Enterprises, Inc., be canceled. Staff notes that in September 1994, in Case No. 96-26, J.T. Enterprises was granted a certificate of service authority by the Commission to provide private pay telephone services. Staff indicates that J.T. Enterprises, a Missouri corporation, is now “dissolved” according to the Missouri Secretary of State’s office. Section 351.476(1), RSMo 2000, provides that “[a] dissolved corporation continues its corporate existence but may not carry on any business except that appropriate to wind up and liquidate its business and affairs. . . .”

Staff also states that mail sent to the company’s addresses has not been returned, but the company has not filed a statement of revenue form for at least the past four years. And although the telephone number provided to the Commission remains live, the line merely rings and rings; repeated attempts have never garnered an answer, nor does the line appear to have a way to leave a message. Staff states that it believes that J.T. Enterprises has violated the terms of its certificate of service authority by 1) its failure

to maintain the authorization to operate in the state of Missouri, and 2) its failure to file statements of revenue.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) gives parties ten days to respond to pleadings. J.T. Enterprises failed to respond.

Section 392.410, RSMo 2000, gives the Commission authority over the granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and finds that it is appropriate to cancel the private payphone certificate granted to J.T. Enterprises.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the private payphone certificate granted to J.T. Enterprises, Inc., in Case No. 96-26 is canceled.
2. That this order shall become effective on December 29, 2005.
