## ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND TARIFFS AND CLOSING CASE

On October 19, 1999, this Commission approved Applicant's tariff implementing a general rate increase, authorized Applicant to sell its water system assets, and directed the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission to notify the Commission when the transfer of assets was completed: "Upon completion of the transfer, the Staff shall immediately so advise the Commission so that McCord's certificate and tariffs may be cancelled." On December 9, 1999, Staff so notified the Commission.

On October 8, 1999, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion seeking authority for McCord to transfer its water system assets to the Village. In that motion, Staff also moved that McCord's certificate and tariffs be cancelled upon consummation of the sale. As McCord no longer possesses a water system, the Commission will cancel its certificate and tariffs.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing McCord Bend Water Company to own, manage, operate, and maintain a water supply system is cancelled.
- 2. That the water service tariffs of McCord Bend Water Company are cancelled.
  - 3. That this Order shall become effective on December 20, 1999.
  - 4. That this case may be closed on December 21, 1999.
