SECOND ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On February 16, 2000, O1 Communications of Missouri, LLC(O1 Communications), filed an application for certificates of service authority to provide basic local, local exchange, and interexchange telecommunications services. On February 28, 2000, the Commission issued an order which directed O1 Communications to clarify which statutes and rules it wished to be waived, and to provide the street and mailing address of its principal office or place of business. On March 9, 2000, O1 Communications filed a Supplement to Application which listed the statutes and regulations it wished to be waived as follows:

On May 2, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its Recommendation in which it recommends that the Commission grant O1 Communications certificates of service authority to provide local exchange, basic local exchange, and interexchange telecommunications services. Staff's Memorandum states that O1 Communications requested waiver of the following Commission rules and statutes:

However, the Commission notes that the list of requested waivers cited by Staff is not the same as the list of waivers listed by O1 Communications in its March 9, 2000, Supplement to Application. First, the list provided by O1 Communications does not request waiver of Section 392.210.2 or Section 392.300.2, although Staff recommends waiver of these provisions. Second, O1 Communications' supplement requests waiver of 4 CSR 240-32.030(1)(B), 4 CSR 240-32.030(1)(C), 4 CSR 240-32.030(2), 4 CSR 240-32.050(3)-(6), and 4 CSR 240-32.070(4), but these regulations are not listed on the Staff Recommendation. Third, the Staff Recommendation references 4 CSR 240-32.030(4)(C), but O1 Communications' pleading requests waiver of 4 CSR 240-32.030(4). It appears that some of the discrepancy can be explained by the fact

that certain provisions of the Code of State Regulations were amended recently; however, the Commission directs the Staff to clarify the discrepancy between the two lists of requested waivers and to amend its Recommendation accordingly.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a revised Staff recommendation or other pleading clarifying the discrepancies between the list of requested waivers found in applicant's Supplement to Application filed March 9, 2000, and those referenced in the Staff Recommendation, filed May 2, 2000. This pleading shall be filed no later than May 18, 2000.

2. That any party may file, no later than May 25, 2000, a response to Staff's revised recommendation or other pleading filed in response to this order.

3. That this order shall become effective on May 18, 2000.
