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

ORDER SUSPENDING ORDER DIRECTING FILING
OF PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On May 24, 2000, the Commission directed the parties in this case to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than 4 p.m. on June 23, 2000. On June 20, 2000, the parties filed a Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement entered into by Advanced TelCom Group, Inc., Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, the Office of the Public Counsel, and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission.

The Commission will suspend its order directing the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule by June 23, 2000 while it considers the parties' Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement. If the Commission approves the parties' Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement, the Commission's order directing the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule will be unnecessary and shall be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Commission's order directing the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than 4 p.m. on June 23, 2000, is

suspended pending consideration of the parties' Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement.

2. That this order shall become effective on July 3, 2000.
