# ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS FILED IN COMPLIANCE WITH A COMMISSION DECISION

On February 1, 2000, the Commission issued its order granting a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Hotel Associates, Inc. (HAI) and directed the company to file tariff sheets with the Commission within 30 days of the effective date of that order. That order was effective on February 14, 2000. On April 17, 2000, HAI filed its proposed tariff.

On May 5, 2000, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve the proposed tariff sheets as filed to become effective on May 17, 2000. Staff noted that on May 1, 2000, HAI filed a substitute sheet No. 4 as sheet No. 4 was inadvertently omitted from the original tariff filing. Staff stated that it has reviewed the tariff submitted by HAI on April 17 and supplemented on May 1, and finds that it is reasonable. Staff further stated that the rates and

rules are in compliance with regulations and the Commission's order issued on February 1, 2000, except that it was late-filed.

The Commission has reviewed HAI's tariff filing and Staff's memorandum. The Commission finds that the tariff sheets filed should be approved for service rendered on or after May 17, 2000.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That tariff file No. 200000951, submitted in Case No.
 WA-99-137 by Hotel Associates, Inc., is hereby approved for service to be rendered on or after May 17, 2000:
