**ORDER AND NOTICE OF APPLICATION**

On April 5, 1999, Osage Water Company (Osage) filed an application with the Commission pursuant to Section 393.170, RSMo 1994<sup>1</sup>, requesting that the Commission grant it a certificate of convenience and necessity to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage and maintain a water and sewer system for the public located in an unincorporated portion of Camden County known as Eagle Woods. Osage states that there are no municipalities located within the proposed service area.

The Commission finds it appropriate that notice of this application be made to the general public and interested parties and that a date for intervention of proper parties be set.

The Records Department of the Commission shall provide notice of this application to the county commission of Camden County. Notice of this application shall also be given by the Information Officer of the Commission to the members of the General Assembly representing

Camden County, and to all publications of general circulation in Camden County as set out in the Official Manual of the State of Missouri.

The requirement of a hearing has been fulfilled when all those having a desire to be heard are offered an opportunity to be heard. If no proper party or governmental entity is granted intervention and neither the Commission's Staff nor the Office of the Public Counsel requests a hearing, the Commission may determine that a hearing is not necessary and that the Applicant may submit its evidence in support of the Application by verified statement. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. P.S.C., 776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989).

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Records Department of the Missouri Public Service Commission is ordered to serve notice as set out herein.
2. That the information officer of the Missouri Public Service Commission is ordered to serve notice as set out herein.
3. That any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than April 29, 1999. Such applications shall be filed with:


