ORDER STAYING FILING OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On January 26, 1999, House Springs Sewer Company (Respondent) filed a request for a stay for filing of the procedural schedule for a period of ninety days from January 26, 1999, up to and including April 26, 1999. The stay was requested on the grounds that Respondent is negotiating a sale of all or substantially all of its assets. Respondent states that if such a sale closes, all of the unpaid assessments due the Commission will be paid from the closing proceeds.


