ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO LATE FILE RESPONSE'AND GRANTING MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

On June 23, 2000, Laclede Gas Company (Laclede) filed a verified application requesting that the Commission grant it the authority to issue and sell various debt and equity instruments. Laclede's application requested that the Commission grant its approval no later than August 23, 2000. However, Laclede did not file a separate motion for expedited treatment as required by 4 CSR 240-2.080(17). Furthermore, Laclede's application did not contain a certificate of service showing service on the Office of the Public Counsel. On June 26, the Commission issued a Notice of Deficiency and Order Directing Compliance that directed Laclede to file a motion for expedited treatment in compliance with the Commission's regulation. That order also directed Laclede to file an appropriate certificate of service. Laclede filed the required



certificate of service on July 3. On the same date, Laclede filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment that is in compliance with the Commission's rule.

On June 26, the Commission issued an Order Directing Staff to Respond to Request For Expedited Consideration. That order directed Staff to file, by July 6, a statement indicating whether or not it would be able to file a Staff Recommendation regarding Laclede's Application by August 10. Staff filed its Response to Motion for Expedited Consideration on July 10, along with a motion requesting leave to file its response out of time.

Staff's Response indicates that it will be able to file a Staff Recommendation in this case within ten business days following the Commission's decision in another case, EF-2000-764. The Commission issued its ruling in EF-2000-764 on July 13. Therefore, Staff's response indicates that it will be able to file a Staff Recommendation no later than July 27.

Given Staff's response, the Commission finds that Laclede's Motion for Expedited Treatment should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That Laclede Gas Company's Motion for Expedited Treatment is granted.
- 2. That Staff shall file its recommendation regarding Laclede Gas Company's Application no later than August 10, 2000.
- 3. That Staff's Motion to Late-File Response to Request for Expedited Consideration is granted.

4. That this order shall become effective on July 27, 2000.
