#### ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO RESPOND

On July 20, 1999, Southern Union Company (Southern Union) filed an application with the Commission requesting authority to acquire up to and including five percent of the common stock of Pennsylvania Enterprises, Inc. (PNT). In a companion case, case number GM-2000-43, Southern Union has requested authority to complete a merger with PNT. Southern Union wishes to immediately purchase a portion of the stock of PNT for the purpose of mitigating the pricing effect of possible arbitrage trading in PNT shares prior to the time of closing of the merger. Southern Union has requested expedited consideration of this application to permit the proposed transactions to occur no later than July 31.

The Commission will attempt to expedite the consideration of this application to the greatest extent possible while honoring its obligation to carefully consider the application.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That no later than July 27, 1999, at 1:00 p.m., the Staff of the Public Service Commission shall file a statement advising the Commission as to whether or not it will be able to file, by July 28, at

4:00 p.m., a Staff recommendation regarding the application of Southern Union for authority to purchase up to and including five percent of the common stock of Pennsylvania Enterprises, Inc.

2. That this order shall become effective on July 26, 1999.
