# ORDER GRANTING DIRECTOR'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE SURREBUTTAL TESTIMONY

On July 9, 2001, the Director of the Division of Manufactured Homes, Recreational Vehicles, and Modular Units filed his motion for extension of time to file surrebuttal

This order grants the Director's motion for more time to file his surrebuttal testimony.

testimony. The Commission had earlier ordered the Director to file the testimony by July

10, 2001.

The motion was filed under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.050, which governs the computation of time allowed by the Commission. Subsection (3) provides that "[w]hen an act is required or allowed to be done by order or rule of the commission at or within a specified time, the commission, at its discretion, may...[o]rder the period enlarged before the expiration of the period originally prescribed...."



The Director's motion stated that:

- The Director would like to file surrebuttal testimony to address Discount Manufactured Housing, Inc.'s rebuttal testimony. Because, however, Director's witness is not in Jefferson City, it's difficult getting all the persons responsible for preparing the surrebuttal testimony together in order to complete it; and
- The Director's counsel has spoken with counsel for Discount and counsel for the Office of the Public Counsel, neither of whom have any objection to the granting of this motion;

The Director thus requested an extension of one week, until July 17, 2001, to file his Surrebuttal Testimony.

The Commission will grant the Director's motion.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Director of the Division of Manufactured Homes, Recreational Vehicles, and Modular Units of the Missouri Public Service Commission must file his surrebuttal testimony no later than July 17, 2001.

2. That this order will become effective on July 17, 2001.
