ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

On July 24, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a Motion to Consolidate in the above-styled cases, stating that all the amendments to the rules in these cases recognize the removal of recreational vehicles from the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to Senate Bill 19, or update terminology to reflect current industry practice. Staff stated that none of the proposed rulemakings have a fiscal impact on the State or any subdivision thereof or on any other public or private entity. Staff stated that these cases could be consolidated into one case to facilitate the processing and speed the implementation of these

proposed rulemakings, if approved by the Commission. No objections to the Staff's Motion to Consolidate were received. Therefore, the Commission will grant Staff's Motion to Consolidate Case No. MX-2000-430, MX-2000-431, MX-2000-433 and MX-2000-445. Case No. MX-2000-430 will be designated as the lead case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Motions to Consolidate filed by the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission in Case Nos. MX-2000-430, MX-2000-431, MX-2000-433 and MX-2000-445, filed on July 24, 2000, are granted and Case No. MX-2000-430 shall be the lead case.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on October 15, 2000.
