

**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF**  
**FILED IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER**

On August 22, 2000, the Commission issued an order granting Lake Region Water & Sewer Company (LRWS) a certificate for an additional sewer service area in Horseshoe Bend in Camden County, Missouri. LRWS filed tariff sheets on August 28, 2000, with an effective date of September 27, 2000. The purpose of the tariff filing was to update LRWS's tariff to be consistent with the addition of the newly approved service area.

Staff reviewed the tariff sheets and filed a Recommendation on September 6, 2000. In Staff's opinion, the tariff sheets accurately reflect the approved additional service area. Staff recommends that the Commission approve the tariff sheets to become effective for sewer service rendered on or after September 27, 2000.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheets and Staff's Recommendation and finds that the tariff sheets conform to the Commission's order of August 22, 2000, and should be approved to become effective September 27, 2000.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the tariff filed by Lake Region Water & Sewer Company on August 28, 2000, and assigned tariff number 200100226, is approved, to become effective on September 27, 2000. The tariff approved is:


