JOINT PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), by and through the undersigned counsel, and on its behalf, that of Mr. Roman Dzhurinskiy (Complainant), and Missouri-American Water Company (Missouri-American or Company), known collectively as the Parties, respectfully states the following to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission):

1. On July 26, 2010, the Staff filed a status report indicating that the Parties had not reached a resolution, and it deemed it helpful for resolution to set an evidentiary hearing date. As the Parties did not object to the filing, the Commission issued an Order on August 13, 2010, directing the Parties to file a joint proposed procedural schedule by September 3, 2010.

2. With the Staff's facilitation, the Parties jointly agree to propose the following schedule for the Commission's consideration:

a. A one (1) day hearing on November 15, 2010, beginning at 10 a.m., at the Commission's Saint Louis office located in the Wainwright State Office Building, 111 North 7th Street, Suite 105, Saint Louis, Missouri, 63101, should the Commission find the location suitable to accommodate a hearing.

A hearing at the Saint Louis location would alleviate some of the Complainant's travel concerns.

- b. The Parties will appear at the hearing and witnesses will give live testimony, in lieu of telephone appearances or the submission of pre-filed testimony.
- c. The Parties will file a Joint List of Issues, List of Witnesses, and Order of Cross Examination (Issue List) by November 1, 2010.
- d. The Parties reserve the right to file a pleading at any time to propose alternative dates for the filing of the Issue List and/or an evidentiary hearing, based upon any outstanding discovery, or disputes related thereto.
- e. The Parties reserve the right to request that the Regulatory Law Judge set a post-hearing briefing schedule at the conclusion of any evidentiary hearing in this matter.

WHEREFORE, the Staff submits this status report on its behalf, and on behalf of the Parties, for the Commission's information and consideration, and requests that the Commission issue an order consistent with the agreements contained herein.
