ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

On September 15, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel the certificate of service authority to provide pay telephone service granted to Premier Pay Payphones, L.L.C. Staff informed the Commission that the company was granted its certificate in Case No. TA-97-35. Staff further stated that it received a letter from the company requesting that the certificate be canceled. Finally, Staff added that the company has not paid its minimal annual assessment for 2006, which was not due at the time the company requested that its certificate be canceled.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) requires that responsive pleadings be filed within 10 days. The company has not responded to Staff's motion. Section 392.410(5), RSMo 2000, states: "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected" The Commission has reviewed the application and the official file and finds that the certificate of service authority granted to Premier Pay Payphones, L.L.C., in Case No. TA-97-35, shall be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the certificate of service authority granted to Premier Pay Payphones,
- L.L.C., in Case No. TA-97-35, is canceled.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on October 8, 2005.
 - 3. That this case may be closed on October 9, 2005.
