## ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

Issue Date: November 22, 2005 Effective Date: December 2, 2005

On November 1, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel the certificate of service authority to provide pay telephone service granted to Cybertech Electronics and Communications, L.L.C. The company was granted a certificate in February of 1996 in Case No. TA-96-206.

In support of its motion, Staff states that although the mail to the company has not been returned, the telephone number is no longer correct. Staff adds that the company does not appear to have ever provided service to Missouri customers. Furthermore, the company has not submitted a Statement of Revenue since fiscal year 2002. The company has not responded to Staff's motion.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-080 (15) states that responsive pleadings must be filed within ten days. Staff's motion was filed on November 1. More than ten days have expired since Staff filed its motion. Staff's motion is therefore unopposed.

Section 392.410(5), RSMo 2000, states: "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or

upon application of the person or company affected . . . ." The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and finding it reasonable shall grant the requested relief.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Staff of the Commission's motion to cancel the certificate of service authority to provide pay telephone service granted to Cybertech Electronics and Communications, L.L.C., is granted.
- 2. That the certificate of service authority to provide pay telephone service granted to Cybertech Electronics and Communications, L.L.C., in Case No. TA-96-206, is canceled.
  - 3. That this order shall become effective on December 2, 2005.
  - 4. That this case shall be closed on December 3, 2005.
