On November 14, 2014, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Inmate Communications' certificate to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri be canceled.

Staff's motion states that they were unable to contact the company and believes the company is no longer providing telecommunications service in Missouri. Inmate Communications also failed to file an annual report or pay any assessment to the Commission.

On November 17, 2014, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Time to Respond to Motion allowing anyone to file a response or request a hearing to do so no later than December 1, 2014. No responses were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo (Supp. 2013), which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the private payphone certificate granted to Inmate Communications Corporation, shall be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The private payphone certificate granted to Inmate Communications Corporation, in Case Number PA-2003-0361, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on December 19, 2014.
3. This case may be closed on December 20, 2014.
