ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

Effective Date: December 31, 2014

This order cancels the private pay telephone certificate of Z Venture Capital Frontiers, Inc.

On November 25, 2014, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Z Venture's certificate to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri be canceled.

In Case Number PA-2009-0320, the Commission granted Z Venture a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri via customer-owned coin-operated telephone equipment.

Staff's motion states that Staff received information that the company is no longer providing service in Missouri. In addition, Staff stated the Company failed to file an annual report or pay any assessment to the Commission. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel Z Venture's certificate of service authority as the company is no longer providing service in Missouri.

On November 26, 2014, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing anyone to file a response or request a hearing to do so no later than December 8, 2014. No responses were filed.


The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo (Supp. 2013), which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the private payphone certificate granted to Z Venture Capital Frontiers, Inc., shall be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The private payphone certificate granted to Z Venture Capital Frontiers, Inc., in Case Number PD-2009-0320, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on December 31, 2014.
3. This case may be closed on January 1, 2015.
