The parties recognize that if the provisions of the unanimous stipulation and agreement filed in this case are carried out quickly enough, a procedural schedule is unnecessary. However, at this time only one of the four contemplated applications has been filed. Therefore, as recognized by the Staff in its Suggestions in Support of the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement, there is a possibility that those intrastate interexchange customers of FFC who have not transferred to another carrier could be without "1+" intrastate interexchange service. This could occur if the d/b/a for FFC from which they are obtaining services has not gotten a permanent certificate and they have not obtained service from another carrier before the temporary certificate for that d/b/a for FFC expires. For this reason, the parties propose the foregoing procedural schedule.

WHEREFORE, the parties jointly request that the Commission issue its Order establishing a procedural schedule as specifically set forth herein.
